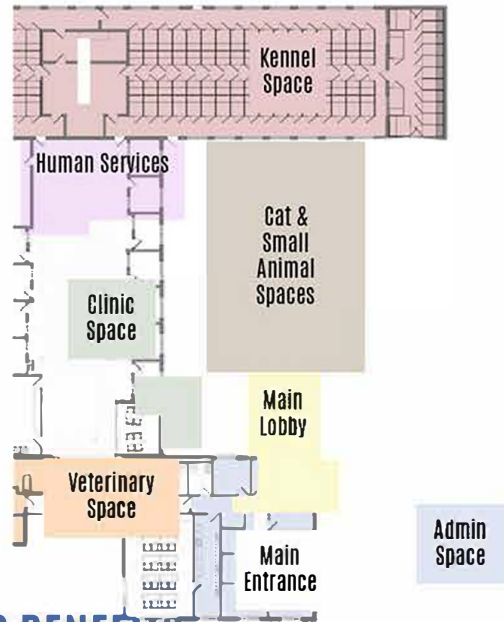

INSIDE THE BUILDING



- **YORK COUNTY SPCA LOBBY - \$25,000**

- The lobby is the central hub of the organization - all people and animals coming and going pass through the lobby every day of the year. Recently renovated, this space is a critical hub for our work and mission.

- **VETERINARY WING - \$15,000**

- The veterinary wing provides critical medical care to every animal that comes through our door - over 2,350+ animals annually! Our dedicated team makes sure that every animal that comes to the shelter receives excellent medical care and ensures our animals are healthy so that they can go to your loving homes.

- **SPAY/NEUTER CLINIC - \$15,000**

- The York County SPCA Spay/Neuter Clinic offers low-cost, high-quality spay/neuter services for dogs and cats in our community, ultimately helping to control the animal population. In 2023, the Spay/Neuter clinic performed over 11,800 spay/neuter surgeries, setting a new record for the fourth year in a row!

- **LARGE CONFERENCE ROOM - \$10,000**

- From staff and board meetings to volunteer training and education classes to adoption events, this room does it all and is an important space in our building.

- **ENTRY - \$7,500**

- This is where every animal's journey starts at the York County SPCA. Entry is where they are initially assessed and receive their first vaccinations.

- **MULTIPURPOSE ROOM - \$7,500**

- Located directly off the lobby, this multipurpose room is seen by practically every visitor that steps foot into the building and is host to weekly small group meetings.

- **CAT CONDO (7) - \$5,000**

- Provides shelter to groups of cats, kittens, and small animals.

- **MEET AND GREET ROOM (2) - \$5,000**

- This is where love connections happen! Hundreds of pets and people meet for the first time in this room when they choose to adopt and provide a loving home to one of our shelter pets.

- **SMALL ANIMAL ROOM - \$5,000**

- Located just off the main lobby, the small animal room provides shelter and care for all of the non-cat and -dog friends that find their way into the shelter - making sure that our guinea pig, bunny, ferret, and other furry friends always have a home until they are adopted.

- **DOG KENNEL (82) - \$2,500**

- Each large and small dog kennels provide shelter and refuge to approximately 12 dogs in a year. Both large dog and small dog kennels are available for sponsorship.

- **CATTERY KENNEL (36) - \$1,000**

- These little houses each provide shelter to approximately 27 cats in a year. Our feline friends are housed front and center, just inside our main lobby.



OUTSIDE THE BUILDING

- **CANINE PLAY YARD (2) - \$5,000**
 - The canine yards provide outdoor enrichment and play space for our canine pals to keep them happy and engaged during their stay.
- **DOG RUN (4) - \$5,000**
 - Our dog runs are part of our canine enrichment program - allowing our shelter pets to get some fresh air and exercise while in our care. Additionally, the runs are also used for meet and greet sessions when making new love connections with adopters and fosters.
- **GAZEBO - \$5,000**
 - Located at the back of the building, the Gazebo provides an area of respite and shade for our staff and volunteers while conducting animal enrichment activities.



VOLUNTEERS

- **VOLUNTEER T-SHIRTS - \$10,000**
 - The York County SPCA has more than 300 active volunteers throughout the year - from dog walkers to clinic support, to landscaping to events. Volunteers serve as ambassadors of the YCSPCA's mission in the community. These iconic blue shirts identify our hardworking helpers. • TALES FOR TAILS - \$15,000

- *SIT. STAY. READ.* Tales for Tails is program for children ages 17 and under to come and read to our shelter animals. We will be hosting 9 sessions in 2025. The sponsorship includes your name listed in all promotions of the sessions and anywhere Tales for Tails is mentioned.

• PET FOOD PANTRY - \$10,000

- The Pet Food Pantry supplied 27,499 pounds of food to families in need in 2023, helping to keep countless pets with their families. The pantry is a popular stop on our facility tour, and your support will be showcased to the hundreds of groups and individuals that get to see the inner workings of the YCSPCA.

• SAFE PET - \$5,000

- Our Safe Pet program houses family pets in times of personal emergencies and crisis. Safe Pet houses displaced animals in a secure location within the shelter that ensures their safety until they can be reunited with their families.

• ADOPTION EVENTS (5) - \$5,000

- Every year the York County SPCA hosts up to six adoption events that include discounted adoption rates for adopters. Showcase your company's philanthropic efforts by sponsoring an adoption event and save animal lives at the same time through adoption. During special adoption events, 20 - 60 (or more!) animals are adopted. Your sponsorship will support these important love connections between people and pets.

• CLEAR THE SHELTERS - \$10,000

- Additionally, YCSPCA participates annually in the national Clear the Shelters event over two full days in August. YCSPCA will be participating on August 9 and 10, 2025. Your sponsorship of Clear the Shelters will help get even more animals out of the shelter and into loving homes. This event drew our largest crowd ever in 2024 and over 100 animals were adopted into new homes!
